Liberal Labor Lies: Election Countdown

Every day between now and the election, a new liberal labor lie will be exposed. On election day, ordinary workers can make a choice. They can support pro-union positions that don't represent their values or their interests, or they can vote in favor of worker freedom.

Liberal Labor Lie of the Day: Social Security personal accounts will impoverish the elderly and bankrupt our children and grandchildren.

FACT: Most Americans and union members don't think so. A 2003 Zogby poll indicated 65% support for personal accounts to save and strengthen Social Security. According to the non-partisan Heritage Foundation, lifetime Social Security losses under the current system average over \$760,000 for a 40-year old married union couple.

Unions are supposed to focus on getting the best workplace deals for workers. Instead, they spend their time fighting political battles their own members don't even support. Workers need to speak their minds and take back their workplace rights from union bosses.
