Liberal Labor Lies: Election Countdown

Every day between now and the election, a new liberal labor lie will be exposed. On election day, ordinary workers can make a choice. They can support pro-union positions that don't represent their values or their interests, or they can vote in favor of worker freedom.

Liberal Labor Lie of the Day: School construction and other municipal projects should be left to the expert craftsmanship of union laborers.

FACT: "Project labor agreements," a nice term for forced unionism, is one of the biggest factors contributing to higher taxes and fewer dollars left in the classroom. When unions get the inside bid on a school construction job, for instance, they ratchet up the costs, leaving less money for schoolchildren.

Unions should not steal money from schoolchildren in order to get a sweetheart construction deal on schools. Parents pay sky-high property taxes expecting the dollars to flow to the classroom, not the contractor.
