Fact of the Day #3: Rep. Leon Drolet is Michigan Taxpayers' Best Friend

2004 in Michigan saw the imposition of higher income taxes, tobacco taxes, and casino taxes. Proposals were floated to raise alcohol taxes, Internet taxes, entertainment taxes, and others.

In this environment, Michigan needs pro-taxpayer legislators to defend families and small businesses.

Rep. Drolet has been the taxpayer's best friend. He is the only primary candidate in House district 33 who has signed the Taxpayer Protection Pledge, a written commitment to "**oppose and vote against any and all tax increases**".

Rep. Drolet:

- **never** voted for a tax increase
- organized the Taxpayer Protection Caucus to fight against tax increases and work for tax cuts
- opposed Gov. Granholm's \$77 million income tax increase
- opposed \$391 million tax increase on tobacco and alcohol
- opposed Internet taxes.
