Colorado TABOR Fact of the Day Where Colorado Tax Dollars are Spent, Part 3

On November 1st, Coloradans will vote on Referenda C and D and will decide on whether to allow state government to keep ALL excess tax revenues beyond the spending limit set by the Taxpayer's Bill of Rights.

Make no mistake-- passage of these measures will result in a tax increase of over \$3.6 billion.

While big-spenders in Colorado claim that vital programs are in need of even more taxpayer dollars, there is clearly enough pork to go around. Here is another example of what taxpayers are funding:

Colorado taxpayers are paying for a \$10,400 subsidy for 2006 to Just Media for a “film profile and chronicle [sic] of the artistic process of creating and installing the ‘Big Blue Bear,’ a sculpture [sic] by Colorado artist Lawrence Argent, at the Colorado Convention Center in Denver.”*

It is time for the big-spenders in Denver to reprioritize, not to raise taxes on Coloradans.

Colorado voters must vote NO on Referenda C and D!
