Sens. Lamborn and Brophy to Chair Taxpayer Protection Caucus in Colorado Senate

*State Senators Doug Lamborn and Greg Brophy to take
the lead in protecting taxpayers' interests*

WASHINGTON - Today, Americans for Tax Reform (ATR) announced that Senators Doug Lamborn (R-El Paso) and Greg Brophy (R-Wray) will become the Taxpayer Protection Caucus Chairs in the Colorado state senate.

To join the caucus, legislators must sign and keep the Taxpayer Protection Pledge, which is a written commitment to their constituents to "oppose and vote against any and all efforts to increase taxes." Every state (with the exception of unicameral Nebraska) will have both a Senate and House Taxpayer Protection Caucus, consisting of all pledge signers in the legislature. Currently, there are 20 Colorado Pledge signers, 7 in the Senate, and 13 in the House.

"Colorado taxpayers are looking forward to seeing their voice strengthened through the new Senate Taxpayer Protection Caucus," said Grover Norquist, president of ATR. **"Under the leadership of Senator Lamborn and Senator Brophy, the Senate Taxpayer Protection Caucus will work and fight for Colorado families and businesses who deserve to keep more of their hard earned money."**

The Taxpayer Protection Caucuses provide a single voice on tax issues among pro-taxpayer legislators, and form entire bodies of legislators that believe in the same principle: No new taxes. Considering the budget battles states are facing across the country, taxes continue to be very high on the radar screen of voters and the media. Journalists will be able to go to the chair of the caucus for comments on tax issues.

"Protecting taxpayers should be the first priority of anyone elected to the state legislature," Norquist continued. **"Senators Lamborn and Brophy understand this important notion, and this is why they choose to jointly take the lead in an effort to protect Colorado taxpayers' wallets."**
