Stop Over Spending Nebraska Fact of the Day: Top 5 Reasons to Vote YES on Amendment 423

On November 7th, Nebraska voters will have the opportunity to put the brakes on unbridled spending in the state legislature when they vote for Measure 423. The Stop Over Spending Amendment would limit increases in state and local government spending to the rate of inflation plus population growth.

Top five reasons to vote YES on Amendment 423 on Nov. 7:	
1	The Stop Over Spending Amendment would alleviate the burden on taxpayers by forcing all levels of government to exercise fiscal restraint just as Maine families do everyday.
2	According to Stop Over Spending Nebraska, for the last 20 years state spending has increased by roughly 228%, while cost of living for Nebraskans increased only 81.8%.
3	Without a spending limit, the people of Nebraska will see their tax bills double within 10 years!
4	Nebraska has gone from being ranked the 14 th highest in the nation for tax burden to 6 th .
5	The amendment would not cut any existing programs and would allow for the legislature to increase funding at a reasonable rate for schools, health care, roads, and other priorities.

Nebraska's level of taxation has reached unsustainable heights.

The Stop Over Spending amendment offers Nebraskans the opportunity to stop tax increases, an action that will create an environment for greater economic growth and job creation.
