Update: Alabama Signers of the No-New-Taxes Pledge

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Americans for Tax Reform announces the following candidates have signed the Taxpayer Protection Pledge. By signing the pledge, a candidate commits “to oppose and vote against any and all efforts to increase taxes.”

President Bush has signed the Pledge, and in so doing he joins 47 U.S. senators, 222 members of the U.S. House of Representatives, six governors, seven lieutenant governors, three attorneys general, four secretaries of state, three treasurers, and more than 1,350 state legislators.
