## Sue Horne Signs No-New-Taxes Pledge

*Candidate for California State Assembly commits to oppose and vote against  
any and all efforts to increase taxes*

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Americans for Tax Reform applauds the pro-taxpayer platform of state legislative candidate Sue Horne (R). Ms. Horne is running to represent voters in the 3<sup>rd</sup> assembly district. The Republican primary for this district is scheduled for June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2008.

Ms. Horne demonstrated her dedication to the taxpayers of California by signing the Taxpayer Protection Pledge on April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2007. By signing the Pledge, she commits to “oppose and vote against any and all efforts to increase taxes.”
