Tim Coleman Signs No-New-Taxes Pledge

Candidate for Attorney General of Kentucky commits to oppose any and all efforts to increase taxes

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Americans for Tax Reform applauds the pro-taxpayer platform of candidate Tim Coleman. Mr. Coleman is running for the office of Attorney General of Kentucky.

Mr. Coleman demonstrated his dedication to the taxpayers of Kentucky by signing the Taxpayer Protection Pledge on February 21st, 2007. By signing the Pledge, Tim Coleman commits to “oppose any and all efforts to increase taxes.”

“Tim Coleman joins numerous elected officials and candidates at the state and federal levels all of whom have committed themselves to the principles of limited government and fiscal restraint,” said Grover Norquist, president of Americans for Tax Reform (ATR).

ATR offers the Taxpayer Protection Pledge to all candidates seeking office at the state and federal levels, and also to sitting incumbents. All candidates running for statewide office in Kentucky have been mailed copies of the Pledge. Additional copies and further information about the Pledge are available on our website at www.atr.org. ATR will inform members of the press about who has and has not signed the Pledge in the months leading up to the May primary and the November general election.

Norquist continued: **“I applaud Mr. Coleman for his commitment to all taxpayers of Kentucky. I extend the invitation to sign the Pledge to every sitting incumbent and every candidate running for office, in the hopes that more elected officials will dedicate themselves to taxpayers, rather than tax-and-spending.”**
