**WOULD VIOLATE TPA AND HARM US  
CREDIBILITY TO NEGOTIATE FUTURE TRADE

The attempt by Speaker Nancy Pelosi to remove the fast-track provision from the US-Colombia Free Trade Agreement is unprecedented and unacceptable. The agreement was negotiated in good faith by the two nations and the United States should uphold their end of that agreement. **Congress must reject this attempt to undermine a deal negotiated in good faith.**

Let those who oppose a deal to allow goods to enter Colombia tariff-free, something their good already do into the United States, vote against the treaty. But to change the rules after a deal has been negotiated will harm the credibility of the United States and hinder the ability of every future Trade Representative to negotiate economically beneficial treaties on behalf of the United States.
