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Support House Concurrent Resolution 312!

As our nation's economy begins to recover, it is imperative that Congress not tamper with the tax relief measure passed last year – the very same measure which is already helping the economy make its way out of recession.

House Concurrent Resolution 312, offered by Reps. Spencer Bachus and Jerry Weller, would express the sense of the House of Representatives that the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 should be left intact, lest the nearly rebounding economy suffer the consequences.

If any part of last year's tax relief bill is postponed, or even worse, eradicated, the practical impact would be, in effect, a tax increase.
