Final Vote results for the Bipartisan Campaign Reform Act

On Wednesday February 14, 2002 The House of Representatives passed H.R. 2356, to amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to provide bipartisan campaign reform by a recorded vote of 240 ayes to 189 noes (Roll Call Number 34).

The bill passed largely along partisan lines, so we have decided to share with you a list of Republicans Voting "Yes" and Democrats Voting "No" on this legislation.
