Taxpayer Coalition Will Hold Press Conference Supporting President's Plan to Reform Social Security

WASHINGTON — **Americans for Tax Reform will hold a press conference on December 11th in support of President Bush's plan to reform the Social Security system.** The President's Commission to Strengthen Social Security will meet in the same building earlier in the day.
