House Healthcare Bill Uses the Term “Tax” 87 Times

WASHINGTON, D.C.—A word search of the 1,990-page House healthcare bill ([H.R. 3962](#)) reveals that the term “tax” is used 87 times, “taxable” is used 62 times, and “excise tax” is used 10 times.
