



Americans for Tax Reform Co-Sponsorship Scorecard for the Pandemic Healthcare Access Act Tax Cut

Senator Ted Cruz (R-Texas) and Representative Ted Budd (R-NC) have introduced the S.3546/H.R. 6338, the “Pandemic Healthcare Access Act,” legislation that expands Health Savings Accounts (HSA) to allow Americans to pay for their healthcare tax free for the duration of the pandemic.

This one-page bill suspends the mandate that an HSA can only be offered with a high deductible health plan (HDHP) for the duration of the COVID-19 emergency pandemic. This legislation would both cut taxes and increase access to healthcare:

- **The Pandemic Healthcare Access Act cuts taxes for millions of Americans.** HSAs allow Americans to save, invest, and spend healthcare dollars tax free. Any money contributed to any HSA is tax deductible, any money invested in an HSA can grow tax free, and any money spent on qualified healthcare expenses from an HSA is tax free.
- **The Pandemic Healthcare Access Act expands healthcare for Americans across the country.** The bill will allow anyone with a health plan to use an HSA. This means hundreds of millions of Americans can have an HSA including those on Medicare and Medicaid, and those that receive care through the VA, Indian health plans, Obamacare and any employer plan. It will also help individuals pay for their deductible or any increased healthcare costs, allow HSA funds to pay for direct primary care, and allow telemedicine below the deductible.

All members of Congress should support this legislation, and President Trump should sign it into law.
